THE LAW OF CHOICES SAYS THAT MY CHOICES...

1. ...ARE ALWAYS MINE ALONE TO MAKE

"So if you know of an opportunity to do the right thing today, yet you refrain from doing it, you're guilty of sin."

2. ...WILL ALWAYS REAP A FUTURE FRUIT

"So if someone takes of this bread and drinks from the Lord's cup improperly—as you are doing—he is guilty of violating the body and blood of our Lord."

Examine yourselves first. Then you can properly approach the table to eat the bread and drink from the cup; because otherwise, if you eat and drink without properly discerning the significance of the Lord's body, then you eat and drink a mouthful of judgment upon yourself. Because of this violation, many in your community are now sick and weak; some have even died. But if we took care to judge ourselves, then we wouldn't have to worry about being judged by another. In fact, the Lord's hand of judgment is correcting us so that we don't suffer the same fate as the rest of the rebellious world: condemnation."
