# BECAUSE I WANT TO SEE AND LOVE THE WORLD LIKE JESUS DID, I NEED MY...

# 1. ...MY LIFE TO MATTER TO THE <u>WHOLE</u> <u>WORLD</u>, NOT JUST <u>MY WORLD</u>

"God wants <u>everyone</u> to be saved and to fully understand the truth."

1 Timothy 2:3-4 (ERV)

#### 3. ...MY LIFE TO BE MARKED BY <u>PEACE-</u> <u>MAKING</u> AND <u>BARRIER BREAKING</u>

If they show deep reverence for God, and are committed to doing what's right, they are acceptable before him.""
