THE CONVICTION OF THE HOLY SPIRIT PROVES TO ME THAT...

1. ...I AM <u>GUILTY</u> OF <u>SIN</u>, CONDEMNED TO <u>DEATH</u>, BUT STILL <u>LOVED</u> BY <u>GOD</u>
