Part 6: "The Reaping"

"Brothers and sisters, when I was with you I found it impossible to speak to you as those who are spiritually mature people, for you are still dominated by the mindset of the flesh. And because you are immature infants in Christ, I had to nurse you and feed you with 'milk,' not with the solid food of more advanced teachings. because you weren't ready for it. In fact, you are still not ready to be fed solid food, for you are living your lives dominated by the mind-set of the flesh. Ask yourselves: Is there jealousy among you? Do you compare yourselves with others? Do you quarrel like children and end up taking sides? If so, this proves that you are living your lives centered on yourselves, dominated by the mind-set of the flesh. and behaving like unbelievers. For when you divide yourselves up in groups—a 'Paul group' and an 'Apollos group'—you're acting like people without the Spirit's influence,

Who is Apollos, really? Or who is Paul? Aren't we both just servants through whom you believed our message? Aren't each of us doing the ministry the Lord has assigned to us? I was the one who planted the church and Apollos came and cared for it, but it was God who caused it to grow.

This means the one who plants is not anybody special, nor the one who waters, for <u>God is the one who brings</u> the supernatural growth.

Now, the one who plants and the one who waters

are equally important and on the same team, but each will be rewarded for his own work. We are coworkers with God and you are God's cultivated garden, the house he is building."

BECAUSE I AM COMMITTED TO MY TRIBE, I WILL...

1. ...ONLY <u>PLANT SEEDS</u> THAT I WANT MULTIPLIED IN MY LIFE

"Make no mistake about it, God will never be mocked! For what you plant will always be the very thing you harvest. The harvest you reap reveals the seed that was planted. If you plant the corrupt seeds of self-life into this natural realm, you can expect to experience a harvest of corruption. If you plant the good seeds of Spirit-life you will reap the beautiful fruits that grow from the everlasting life of the Spirit.

Galatians 6:7-8 (TPT)

"Sin is a seed that brings a harvest; <u>you'll reap a heap of trouble with every seed you plant</u>. For your investment in sins pays a full return—the full punishment you deserve!"

Proverbs 22:8 (TPT)

"Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. 'For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.' And God will generously provide all you need.
