IF I WANT TO GET BUSY RAISING MY KIDS THE RIGHT WAY, I HAVE TO...

1. ...BE THE <u>CLEAR</u> ABOUT <u>WHO LEADS</u> MY HOME

"But if you don't want to serve the Lord, you must choose for yourselves today whom you will serve. You may serve the gods that your ancestors worshiped when they lived on the other side of the Euphrates River, or you may serve the gods of the Amorites who lived in this land. <u>As for me and my</u> family, we will serve the Lord."

"You and your family are to remember the Sabbath Day; set it apart, and keep it holy. You have six days to do all your work, but the seventh day is to be different; it is the Sabbath of the Eternal your God. Keep it holy by not doing any work—<u>not you,</u> your sons, your daughters, your male and female servants, your livestock, or any outsiders living among you. For the Eternal made the heavens above, the earth below, the seas, and all the creatures in them in six days. Then, on the seventh day, He rested. <u>That is why He blessed</u> the Sabbath Day and made it sacred."

2. ...BE CONSTANT WITH THE WORDS I CHOOSE

"You should love Him, your True God, with all your heart and soul, with every ounce of your strength. Make the things I'm commanding you today part of who you are. <u>Repeat them to your children</u>. <u>Talk</u> <u>about them when you're sitting together in your</u> <u>home and when you're walking together down the</u> <u>road</u>. <u>Make them the last thing you talk about</u> <u>before you go to bed and the first thing you talk</u> <u>about the next morning</u>. Do whatever it takes to remember them: tie a reminder on your hand and bind a reminder on your forehead where you'll see it all the time, such as on the doorpost where you cross the threshold or on the city gate."

Deuteronomy 6:5-9 (TVB)

"All Scripture is given by God. <u>And all Scripture is</u> <u>useful for teaching</u> and for showing people what is wrong in their lives. 3. ...BE CONSISTENT WITH THE EXAMPLE I SET
