Part 7: The Maturity Stone

"When the Philistine stood up and approached. David ran toward the line of battle to meet him. As quick as a flash, he reached into his bag, put a stone in his sling, and launched it at the Philistine, hitting him in the head. The stone sank deeply into his forehead, and the Philistine fell face-first onto the ground. That was how David defeated the Philistine with only a sling and a single stone, striking him down, ending his life without a sword in his hand. Then David ran to the Philistine and stood over his lifeless body. He pulled the man's sword from its scabbard and finished him by cutting off his head. When the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they knew they would be next, so they ran away."

THE STONE OF MATURITY IS THE MOST DIFFICULT TO CHOOSE AND TO CARRY BECAUSE IT...

1. ...STARTS AS SHARP-EDGED BELIEFS

"Go out and preach the word! Go whether it's an opportune time or not! Reprove, warn, and encourage; but do so with all the patience and instruction needed to fulfill your calling because a time will come when some will no longer tolerate sound teaching.

Instead, they will live by their own desires; they'll scratch their itching ears by surrounding themselves with teachers who approve of their lifestyles and tell them what they want to hear. They will turn away from the real truth you have to offer because they prefer the sound of fables and myths."

"So, my friends, while we wait for the day of the Lord, work hard to live in peace, without flaw or blemish: and look at the patience of the Lord as your salvation. Our dearly loved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him. has written about this. He says essentially the same in all of his letters. although uneducated and unstable readers misinterpret the difficult passages, just as they always misread Scripture, to their spiritual ruin. So hear my final words. my friends. 2. ...ONLY BECOMES <u>SMOOTH</u> THROUGH BEING REPEATEDLY PUT TO WORK
