

GOD Part 4: "The Love of God" Story of Jonah

"We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in his love. <u>God is love</u>, and all who live in love live in God, and God lives in them. And as we live in God, <u>our love grows more perfect...</u>"

I AM PERFECTED IN GOD'S LOVE, AS I...

1. ... WALK IN OBEDIENCE.

"Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?...Nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 8:35,39b (NLT)

GOD'S LOVE PURSUES.

"We love because he first loved us."

1 John 4:19 (NIV)

"This is how we've come to understand and experience love: Christ sacrificed his life for us. This is why we ought to live sacrificially for our fellow believers, and not just be out for ourselves. If you see some brother or sister in need and have the means to do something about it but turn a cold shoulder and do nothing, what happens to God's love? It disappears. And you made it disappear."

1 John 3:16-17 (MSG)

2. ... LAY DOWN MY LIFE.

Jesus: "The Father loves Me because I am willing to lay down My life—but I will take it up again. My life cannot be taken away by anybody else; I am giving it of My own free will. My authority allows Me to give My life and to take it again. All this has been commanded by My Father."

John 10:17-18 (VOICE)

"For even the Son of Man did not come expecting to be served by everyone, but to serve everyone, and to give his life as the ransom price in exchange for the salvation of many."

GOD'S LOVE PROVIDES

"...So we will not be afraid on the day of judgment, but we can face him with confidence because we live like Jesus here in this world. Such love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear. If we are afraid, it is for fear of punishment, and this shows that we have not fully experienced his perfect love."

3. ...PRACTICE REPENTANCE

"That is why the Lord says, 'Turn to me now, while there is time. Give me your hearts. Come with fasting, weeping, and mourning. Don't tear your clothing in your grief, but tear your hearts instead.' Return to the Lord your God, for he is merciful and compassionate, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love. He is eager to relent and not punish."

GOD'S LOVE <u>PARDONS</u>

Jesus: "The people of Nineveh will stand up against this generation on judgment day and condemn it, for they repented of their sins at the preaching of Jonah. Now someone greater than Jonah is here—but you refuse to repent."

4. ... LOVE PEOPLE.

• GOD'S LOVE IS PASSIONATE
