We should not be surprised, based on what we see in scripture:

"But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these."

**2 Tim 3:1-5** (NASB95)

And lest you think this is confined to the unbelieving world (where this would be expected), it is not; it has infiltrated the church.

Satan is the prince of the power of the air and his supreme goal is to undermine every plan of God. Scripture says he is the Father of Lies:
