IF I WANT TO BE “IN LOVE” WITH WHO I AM, I HAVE TO...

1. ...STOP TRYING TO BE SOMEONE I’M NOT SUPPOSED TO BE

“Don’t worry about a thing,’ David told him. ‘I’ll take care of this Philistine!’ ‘Don’t be ridiculous!’ Saul replied. ‘How can a kid like you fight with a man like him? You are only a boy, and he has been in the army since he was a boy!’ But David persisted...Saul finally consented, ‘All right, go ahead,’ he said, ‘and may the Lord be with you!’

*Then Saul gave David his own armor—a bronze helmet and a coat of mail.
