• **CONFORMITY**

"Then Pilate asked the crowd again, 'So what should I do with this man you call the king of the Jews?' They shouted, 'Crucify him!' Pilate asked, 'Why? What wrong has he done?' THE MOST POWERFUL WAY TO FIGHT FOR MY IDENTITY IS...

1. ... CONSIDERING WHO CREATED ME AND WHY

"God spoke: <u>'Let us make human beings in</u> <u>our image</u>, make them reflecting our nature, <u>so they can be responsible for the fish in the</u> sea, the birds in the air, the cattle, and, yes,

Earth itself, and every animal that moves on the face of Earth.' God created human beings; he created them godlike, reflecting God's nature. He created them male and female.

God blessed them: 'Prosper! Reproduce! Fill Earth! Take charge! Be responsible for fish in the sea and birds in the air, for every living thing that moves on the face of Earth."

2. ... CONFIDENCE IN WHAT I'M CAPABLE OF DOING

"Look carefully at your call, brothers and sisters. By human standards, not many of you are deemed to be wise. Not many are considered powerful. Not many of you come from royalty, right? But celebrate this: God selected the world's foolish to bring shame upon those who think they are wise; likewise, He selected the world's weak to bring disgrace upon those who think they are strong."

3. ...<u>COURAGE</u> TO DO WHAT <u>NEEDS TO</u> BE <u>DONE</u>
