1. THE CHURCH IS <u>DESIGNED</u> FOR WORSHIP

God designed us for <u>Himself</u>

"For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him."

Colossians 1:16

God designed us for Worship

"In Christ we have also obtained an inheritance,[a] having been destined according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to his counsel and will, so that we, who were the first to set our hope on Christ, might live for the praise of his glory.

Ephesians 1:11-12

God designed us to <u>Sing</u>

God didn't call us all to be great <u>singers</u>, but for all of us to sing to His <u>greatness</u>.

- There are <u>400</u> direct references to singing
- There are <u>50</u> direct commands to sing
- Longest book in the Bible-Psalms

"Sing praises to God, sing praises; Sing praises to our King, sing praises."

Psalm 47:6

"Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth.

<u>Sing</u> to the Lord, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day."

Psalm 96:1-2

- Singing is one of God's <u>love languages.</u>
- 2. WHEN WE DON'T SING AND WORSHIP GOD, IT"S NOT BECAUSE WE DON'T <u>CARE</u>, BUT BECAUSE WE AREN'T <u>AWARE</u> OF WHAT HAPPENS WE WORSHIP.
 - We are not aware that He's <u>Present with</u> us.

"For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them."

Matthew 18:20

- When we <u>show</u> up for God, He always shows up for us.
- We are not aware of our singular capacity to make God happy.

"I will praise God's name in <u>song</u> and glorify him with thanksgiving.

This will <u>please</u> the Lord more than an ox, more than a bull with its horns and hooves."

Psalm 69:30-31

"...find out what pleases the Lord."

Ephesians 5:10

- Worship is not for us.
- We are not aware of our need for <u>Perspective</u>
