## GOD CREATED THE CHURCH BECAUSE GATHERING AS A COMMUNITY...

## 1. ...REMINDS ME I CAN'T <u>GROW</u> WITHOUT BEING <u>WATERED</u>

"<u>Discover creative ways to encourage others and to</u> motivate them toward acts of compassion, doing beautiful works as expressions of love. This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together, as some have formed the habit of doing, <u>because</u> we need each other! In fact, <u>we should come</u> together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning."

## Hebrews 10:24-25 (TPT)

"And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful. Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts." ## 2. ...<u>MULTIPLIES</u> MY CAPACITY FOR GOD'S PROVISION

# 3. *...*NEVER LETS ME FORGET THAT A <u>HEALTHY</u> <u>FAMILY</u> IS A <u>GROWING</u> FAMILY

A community's health is measured by two inarguable conditions:

## Growth in <u>Numbers</u>

After this, the church all over Judea, Galilee, and Samaria experienced a season of peace. <u>The</u> <u>congregations grew larger and larger, with the</u> <u>believers being empowered and encouraged by the</u> <u>Holy Spirit</u>. They worshiped God in wonder and awe, and walked in the fear of the Lord." **Acts 9:31** (TPT)

"There were <u>about 5000</u> men there who ate." Matthew 14:21 (ERV)

"During this time, when <u>about 120 believers</u> were together in one place..."

Acts 1:15 (NLT)

"Then those people who accepted what Peter said were baptized. <u>About three thousand people</u> were added to the number of believers that day." **Acts 2:41** (NCV)

"...Jesus was seen by <u>more than five hundred of</u> <u>the believers</u> at the same time."

## • Growth in Maturity

"Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. This will continue until we all come to such <u>unity in our faith</u> and <u>knowledge of God's Son</u> that <u>we will be mature in</u> <u>the Lord</u>, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ."
