ZEPHANIAH WARNED GOD'S PEOPLE TO REPENT

WHAT IS REPENTANCE? REPENTANCE IS TURNING AWAY FROM SIN AND TURNING TO JESUS.

When Josiah was the king of Judah, God gave a message to a prophet named Zephaniah. God said a day is coming called “the Day of the Lord.” On that day, God is going to punish people for their sin.

God said, “I will get rid of all the things and places My people used to worship false gods.”

Zephaniah told the people what an awful day the Day of the Lord will be: a day of wrath, a day of trouble, a day of destruction, a day of darkness, a day of clouds and blackness. The Lord will show His anger because everyone has sinned against Him.

This was terrible news! What were people to do? “Come together before it is too late,” Zephaniah said. “Change your ways. Turn to God and obey Him. Be humble. Maybe you will be safe from God's anger.”

God would also judge the countries around Judah.

God told the people what was coming so that they would learn a lesson. “I want you to fear Me and respect Me,” God said.

Then Zephaniah gave the people hope. When all these terrible punishments happened because of sin, God would keep safe the people who trust in Him. God promised restoration; He will fix everything, making it like new.

The day when God makes things right will be such a happy day for His people.

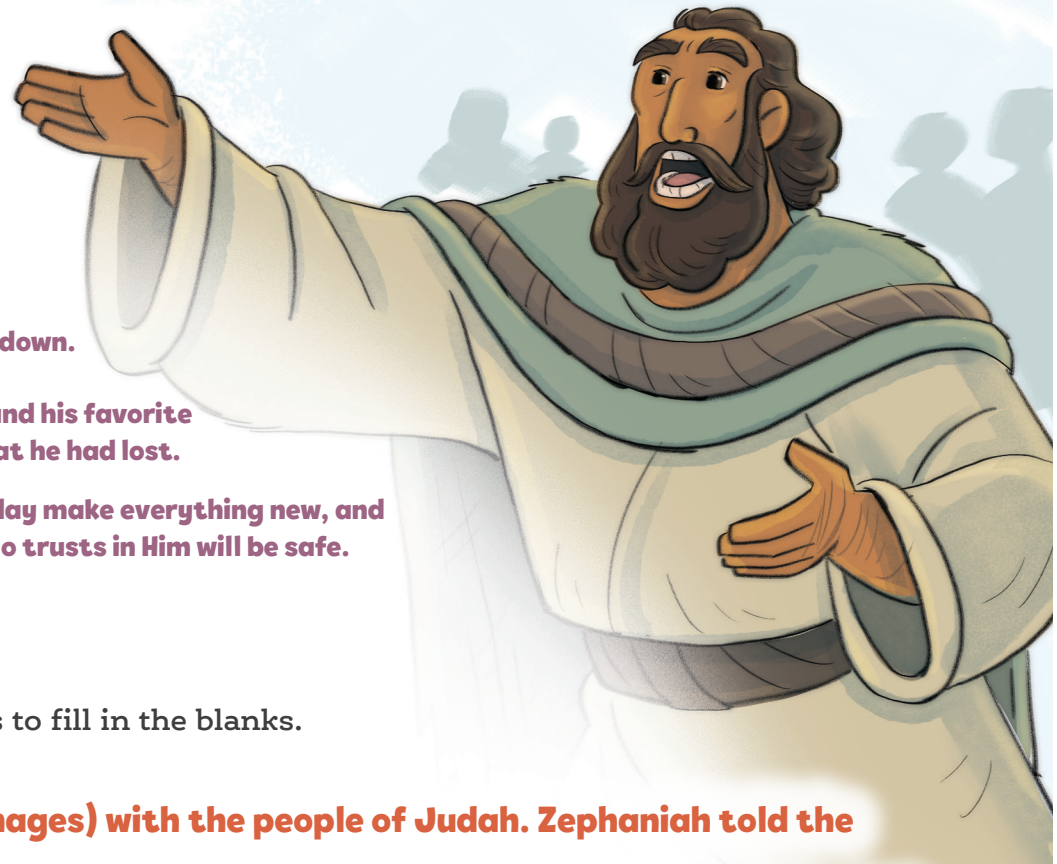
