### I'M BOTHERED BY THE NEW THING GOD BIRTHS IN MY LIFE, BECAUSE...

### 1. ... IT WILL TEST MY \_\_\_\_

"At this time, a man called Simeon was living in Jerusalem. He was a good man and he obeyed God. He had waited a long time to see the special person who would save Israel's people. The Holy Spirit was with him. The Holy Spirit had told him, 'You will not die yet. You know that the Lord God has promised to send his Messiah. You will see him before you die.' Now the day had come. The Holy Spirit told Simeon that he should go to the temple. Mary and Joseph were bringing the baby Jesus to do what God's rule said. Simeon went to them, He took Jesus and he held him in his arms. Then he thanked God. He said: 'Master. I am your servant. You have done what you promised to me. Now I can die with no trouble in my mind. I really have seen the person that you have sent to save your people. You have sent him to the world and people everywhere will know about him. He will bring light to people so that they

can know you. He will show you to those people who are not Jews. He will also show that your people of Israel are very special.' That is what Simeon said about Jesus. His message surprised Mary and Joseph very much."

# 2. ...IT WILL \_\_\_\_\_\_ WHO I REALLY

"Then Simeon asked God to be good and kind to Mary and to Joseph. After that, he spoke to Mary, the mother of Jesus. He said to her, 'God has chosen this baby. <u>Many people in</u> <u>Israel will become worse because of him</u>. And many of them will become better again because of him. He will be like a sign that points to God. But <u>many people will speak</u> <u>against him</u>. This <u>will show their secret</u> <u>thoughts about God</u>. This <u>will make you very</u> <u>sad</u>, too. It will seem <u>like a sharp knife is</u> <u>cutting into you</u>. That is how sad you will be."" **Luke 2:34-35** (EASY)

"Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea. This happened while Herod was king of Judea. <u>After</u> <u>Jesus' birth</u>, Wise Men from the east came to Jerusalem. They asked, 'Where is the child who has been born to be <u>king of the Jews</u>? We saw his star when it rose. Now <u>we have come</u> <u>to worship him</u>.' <u>When King Herod heard about</u> <u>it, he was very upset</u>. Everyone in Jerusalem was troubled too."

"When King Herod heard about it, he was very upset. Everyone in Jerusalem was troubled too. So Herod called together all the chief priests of the people. He also called the teachers of the law.
